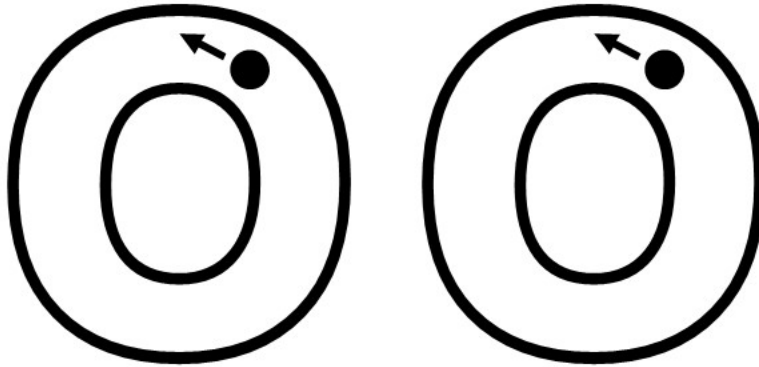


# Letter Formation
